



USE OF VIDEO IN ANADOLU UNIVERSITY OPEN EDUCATION SYSTEM

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Abstract

Anadolu University Open Education System has been using videos as a learning material since its inception. When teaching started in 1982 academic year, TV programs prepared for distance education students were broadcasted by TRT. After a period beginning with the principle of "preparing a television program for each unit", TV programs continued to be produced in line with the media planning principle. Production and broadcasting of educational television programs, which lasted until 2008-2009 academic year, were interrupted in 2009-2010. On January 31, 2011, Anadolu University's agreement with TRT started broadcasting of TRT School and television programs prepared for Open Education System students started broadcasting on this channel. The broadcasting times of the programs of this period have been planned by Anadolu University and produced with a renewed understanding. The television programs produced in this period have also been moved to digital media through Anadolu University's official website, YouTube and TRT School Internet pages. At the end of January, 2017, TRT School broadcasting were finalized. In the following period, instead of television programs, videos are being prepared for different purposes such as education, promotion, information, lifelong learning, which are presented in e-learning environments. The environments where these videos are placed today are Open Education System e-learning portal, official YouTube page, official Facebook page and official mobile application Anadolu Mobil.

The aim of this study is to evaluate the changes in the use of the Open Education System as a training material and the use of video which is strengthened as a necessity of the age.
