



THE VALIDITY AND RELIABILITY OF TURKISH VERSION OF THE COPING COMPETENCE QUESTIONNAIRE

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Abstract

The aim of this study is to examine validity and reliability of the Turkish version of the the Coping Competence Questionnaire (Schroder & Ollis, 2013). The sample of this study consisted of 261 undergraduate students. The results of confirmatory factor analysis indicated that The Coping Competence Questionnaire Scale model was well fit ($\chi^2= 123.98$, $df= 44$, $RMSEA= .082$, $CFI= .95$, $IFI= .95$, $NFI= .92$, $SRMR= .062$). The internal consistency reliability coefficient of the scale was .89. The corrected item-total correlations ranged from .35 to .70. Overall findings demonstrated that this scale had high validity and reliability scores.
